

Central Oregon Collective Impact Initiatives

Kindergarten Readiness- Led by the Central Oregon Health Council and Early Learning Hub, ensuring children receive the opportunities and support needed to enter school ready to succeed

TRACE's (Trauma, Resilience & Adverse Childhood Experiences)- Led by United Way, providing resources and creating systems for families, educators and communities that build resilience, address ACE's, and promote health & well-being

Latino Success Initiative- Aligned and integrated solutions to partnering with Latino families to ensure access to information and resources to close gaps in outcomes for Latino students

8+9 Project- Bridging the vulnerable summer transition between 8th and 9th grade and linking students with positive adult mentors

Cascades Commitment- Led by School Improvement at the High Desert Education Service District, creating a clear path for all high school students to earn college credit in High School
